



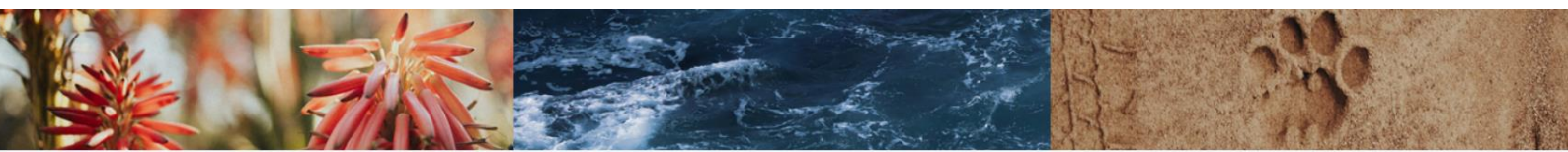

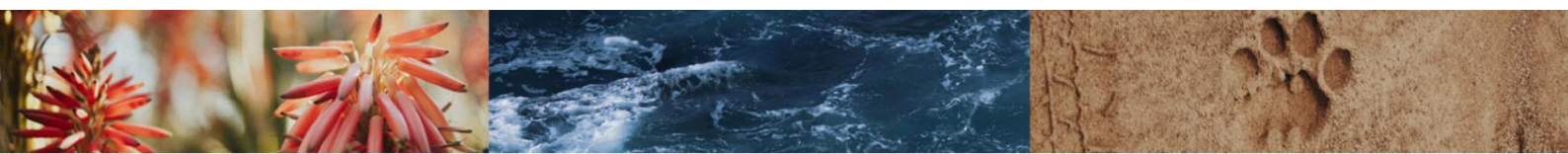

Itinerary:

Days 1-4: Greater Kruger, Thornybush Game Reserve

On arrival at Hoedspruit Airport, a driver will meet you and transfer you to your lodge, where you'll settle into the African bush environment.

Your first stay will be at the luxurious Thornybush Game Lodge or the stylish Saseka Tented Camp, both set within the renowned Thornybush Game Reserve in the Greater Kruger area. Over the next few days, you'll enjoy a balance of impact activities (detailed below) and morning and afternoon game drives led by expert guides.

This reserve is celebrated for its exceptional game viewing, giving you the chance to encounter Africa's iconic wildlife—lion, leopard, buffalo, elephant, and rhino—along with zebra, giraffe, hippo, and a wide array of other species. It's a rare opportunity to witness these animals in their natural habitat while also engaging in experiences that make a positive difference.

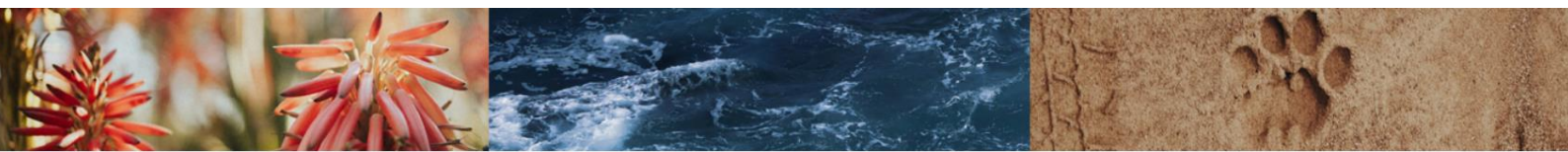
