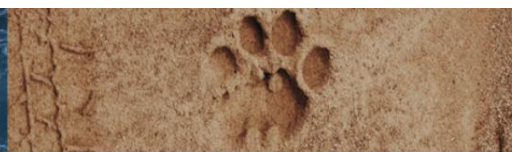
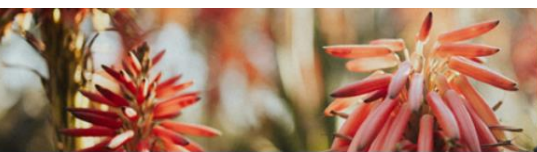

Day 1: Cape Town arrival

Day 2: Cape Town City Tour & Table Mountain

This is a great way to get an introduction to “the Mother City,” Cape Town. Go for a tour in the city and surrounding area, including the city centre, Company’s Gardens, Cape Town Castle, the Bo Kaap, Signal Hill, and the V&A Waterfront. A big part of this tour is walking around the city with your guide getting to know the city, its different cultures, history, and geography. A highlight of the day is riding to the top of the famous Table Mountain in a cable car, for magnificent views over Table Bay, Robben Island, The Cape Peninsula and Lions Head.

Day 3: Cape Peninsula Tour

Join us on a spectacular journey to the Cape of Good Hope, including a visit to the African Penguin colony at Boulders Beach. We’ll explore Cape Point National Park on foot by taking a walk up to the lighthouse (or opt to take the “Flying Dutchman” funicular). We will then head to the Cape of Good Hope, the furthest southwestern point in Africa. Our day will include driving along the beautiful Atlantic seaside suburbs of Clifton and Camps Bay, with views of the Twelve Apostles Mountains. We will also enjoy a spectacular coastal drive along Chapman’s Peak, to take in one of the best views in the region.

Day 4: Cape Winelands Tour

The Western Cape of South Africa is home to more than 500 wineries, and today we will visit a few of our favourites in the Stellenbosch wine region. We typically visit three wineries, and we like to consult with our clients on the day to tailor the stops to their tastes. Some of our current favourites are:

- [Uva Mira](#), a boutique winery situated on the slopes of the Helderberg Mountain range
- [Jordan Wine Estate](#), a picturesque family-owned estate
- [Warwick](#), award-winning wines and the first estate to produce a 'Cape Blend'
- [Stark-Condé](#), spectacular Cabernet Sauvignon with spectacular views
- [Babylonstoren](#), at the foot of Simonsberg Mountain in the Franschhoek wine valley, with a fruit and vegetable garden of amazing beauty and diversity
- [Boschendal](#), with its garden-to-table restaurant, historic manor buildings, garden picnics, and exceptional food & wine
- [Muratie Wine Estate](#), a Stellenbosch farm dating back to 1685, one of the oldest estates in South Africa (with the cobwebs to prove it)
- [Rust en Vrede](#), specializing in robust red wines like Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah
- [Oldenberg](#), a hidden gem with great views of the Banhoek Valley

Day 5: Stellenbosch – Mossel Bay - Wilderness

We depart Stellenbosch early and make our way to the Garden Route. We enter the Garden Route at Mossel Bay, known as the landing site of the first European mariners to round the southern tip of Africa. There we can spend some time on the spectacular beaches or hike the Cape St. Blaize trail along the cliffs overlooking the Indian Ocean. Alternatively, we can go straight through to Wilderness, to check into our seaside accommodation for the evening.

Day 6: Wilderness – Knysna - Plett

Today we explore the heart of the Garden Route, Knysna. This stretch of coast is known for its lovely scenery, including indigenous forest, a large warm-water estuary, and the Outeniqua Mountains.

On arrival in Johannesburg, guests will be transferred to their guest house or hotel for the evening. Enjoy an evening at leisure, with the in-house restaurant as a dinner option.

In the morning, guests will be transferred to Johannesburg airport for a short flight to Hoedspruit Airport.

Welcome to Greater Kruger. We will arrange a driver to meet & greet you at Hoedspruit Airport and take you to get settled into your safari lodge for the next 2 nights.

Enjoy a 2-night safari in the Greater Kruger area. Go on morning and afternoon game drives in this beautiful part of Greater Kruger, hoping to spot the wildlife that Africa is famous for: lion, leopard, Buffalo, elephant, rhino, zebra, giraffe, hippo, and many more. This area of the Greater Kruger is renowned for excellent game viewing, and this is a great opportunity to see wildlife in its natural environment.

- Tour price is dependent on group size and vehicle size. Should the group size fluctuate from the original quote, your Earthstompers consultant will provide you with a revised quote.
- Your guide will be available to do the activities mentioned in this itinerary, which is generally 8-10 hours for a full day. If you would like additional help planning evening activities and dinner, please speak to your guide – he or she can assist you with making arrangements for evening taxis or dinner reservations.



- All vehicles have valid operating licences to convey paying customers.
